

Patron code of Conduct:

1. The following activities are not allowed on library premises:
 - a. Soliciting not directly related to library business.
 - b. Unauthorized eating or drinking.
 - c. Sleeping or using the library as a temporary residence.
 - d. Smoking or engaging in substance abuse.
 - e. Creating excessive noise or engaging in other disruptive behavior.
 - f. Misusing the restrooms.
 - g. Harassing or harming library patrons or personnel, whether physical or verbal.
 - h. Tampering with, defacing, or damaging library materials, equipment, furniture, or the building.
 - i. Entering non-public areas unless escorted by a staff member.
 - j. Carrying weapons, except by law enforcement personnel.
 - k. Bringing of animals into the library except those needed to assist a person with a disability.
 - l. Removing library materials without having checked them out.
 - m. Unauthorized using of equipment such as phones, computers, video players, etc.
 - n. Unauthorized using of chargeable services such as long distance phone calls or fee-for-access Internet services.
 - o. Engaging in any other conduct inconsistent with normal and reasonable behavior of a library patron.
2. Inside the library attire must include shoes and shirts. Designs, graphics and lettering on clothing should be appropriate to being viewed by younger patrons and personnel.
3. Patrons may be asked to leave and library privileges may be otherwise limited or suspended for violating the rules of conduct as set forth above. Law enforcement officials are available to assist in this regard.
4. Theft of any kind while on library premises will be handled as a legal issue, with police being notified upon discovery.
